To: Property Owners and Residents on E. & W. Mifflin Street & N. Pinckney Street

Re: Sidewalk & Bench Construction on Capitol Square

The City of Madison is planning to begin construction on the sidewalk and benches on East & West Mifflin Street and North Pinckney Street along the Capitol Square.

The construction includes:

- Replacing damaged concrete & brick sidewalk with concrete exposed aggregate sidewalk
- Replacing brick benches with the black metal State Street style benches
- Installing granite curb around planters

The project is scheduled to begin on the week of May 4, 2009. It will be complete on July 3, 2009 with the possible exception of granite curbing of the planters. Granite Curbing has a long delivery time. If the granite curb is not installed by July 3, 2009, the site will be left at grade with concrete. The curb will then be installed when it is delivered.

The City of Madison has awarded the contract to Speedway Sand & Gravel, Inc. The street will be open and sidewalk access will be provided at all times of the project. Every effort will be made to minimize the inconvenience to residents and businesses. No active work is allowed during Capitol Square events.

The City has assigned Ms. Lauri Ziegler-Henderson to be the Inspector of the project. The Inspector's role is to see that the City's standards for construction are met and to help resolve any problems that may arise during construction. 
