

ALL VEHICLES HAVE THESE RESTRICTIONS:

Must enter and exit State Street from the nearest intersecting street to their destination.
Must be actively loading or unloading (No more than 10 minutes without activity).

ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS:

(Fines start at \$25 plus additional fees if towed)

AUTOS

- Only allowed on State Street when:
 - Transporting persons with a disability that limits their ability to walk to a location on State St.



– OR –

When displaying a State Street Auto Permit and doing one of the following:

- Furnishing delivery or maintenance service functions.
- Picking up or returning large, bulky or heavy merchandise.
- Do not park in loading zones except on Sundays and holidays.
- In 100-200 blocks, a minimum of 2 wheels must be on terrace.
- In 300-600 blocks, all 4 wheels must be on terrace if room permits, otherwise 2 wheels must be on terrace.
- Maximum of 30 minutes. Must be engaged in loading or unloading.

MOTOR TRUCKS

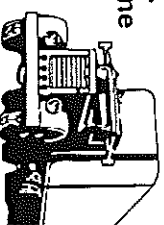
(4 wheeled vehicles with truck plates)

- Allowed on State Street when delivering or receiving merchandise or services, but cannot stop, stand or park from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- In 100-200 blocks, a minimum of 2 wheels must be on terrace.
- In 300-600 blocks, must park in loading zones if available, otherwise all 4 wheels must be on terrace if room permits, otherwise 2 wheels must be on terrace.

LARGE MOTOR TRUCKS

(Trucks with 6 wheels or more)

- Allowed on State Street when delivering or receiving merchandise or services, but cannot stop, stand or park from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- Must park in loading zone of block being serviced if available. Otherwise, all wheels on one side must be on terrace.
- May not park opposite another large motor truck.



LICENSED TAXI CABS



Limousines, private buses, rental vehicles and hotel vans are not allowed on State St.

- Only allowed for sole purpose of receiving or discharging passengers specifically requesting service.
- Licensed taxi cabs are allowed to post in the pullout/loading zones during specified evening hours.

EXCEPTIONS

- Authorized emergency vehicles.
- Authorized government vehicles and Metro buses.
- City or public utility vehicles while engaged in maintenance, repairs or inspections.
- Motor trucks parked pursuant to a street occupancy permit.

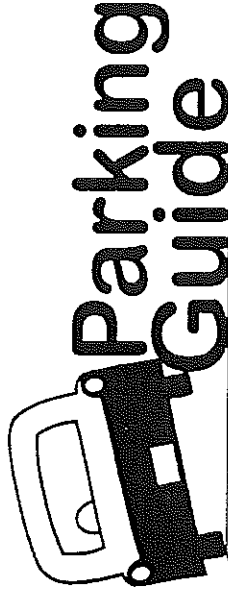


State Street Mall Ordinances

- 105** State St. automobile -- no stopping, standing or parking -- for limited purposes only
- 107** State St. automobile permit Violations
- 108** State St. automobiles -- manner of parking
- 109** State St. automobile -- no parking in loading zone except Sunday or holidays
- 122** State St. automobile parking more than 30 minutes
- 123** No stopping, standing, parking of motor trucks on State St. 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- 124** State St. motor truck no stopping, standing or parking for purposes not allowed
- 125** State St. motor truck loading violation
- 126** State St. motor truck -- manner of parking
- 127** No stopping, standing, parking of large motor trucks on State St. 11:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.
- 128** State St. large motor truck parking for purposes not allowed
- 129** State St. large motor truck loading violation
- 130** State St. large motor truck manner of parking (2 trucks across from each other)
- 131** State St. large motor truck manner of parking (outside loading zone or without wheels on curb)
- 132** State St. large motor truck idling
- 134** State St. food delivery vehicle -- too many vehicles (before 5 p.m. = 1 max., 5 to 9 p.m. = 2 max., 9 p.m. to close -- 1 max.)

Qualifications and Conditions: Permission to operate an automobile on the State Street Mall will only be granted to those establishments, persons or organizations who meet the following conditions:

1. Furnishing transportation for persons with a disability that limits or impairs the ability to walk.
2. Furnishing delivery or maintenance service functions.
3. Picking up or returning merchandise so large, bulky, or heavy that vehicular access immediately adjacent to the establishment is necessary.
4. In the 100-200 block, there shall be a minimum of two wheels on the curb.
5. In the 300-600 block, all four wheels must be on the curb, if possible.
6. Do not park in Loading Zones except for Sunday and Holidays.
7. Parking time is limited to 30 minutes while *ACTIVELY* loading and unloading.
8. Enter State Street from nearest cross street and exit at the closest intersection.

PENALTY: Violation of the penalty requirements may be \$20 to \$50 plus costs.
